Ángel Díaz Cobo is an EOI teacher (1988-present), and Associate teacher of Spanish as a FL at Warsaw University and Cervantes Institute in Warsaw (2007-2010). He researched and published on Continuous Assessment at EOI and on using CEFR-based rating scale assessment tools for Spanish CLIL courses (2008). He coordinated a European Language Label-awarded EOI teaching project (2004), developed the Andalusian EOI language curriculum, wrote EOI official certification exams and contributed to its rating scales design. He trains initial/in-service teachers on language evaluation, rating scale assessment and mediation.
